Workshop 1: LGBTQI rights in Israel (and Germany) - Din O. Baartz

The lecture will give an insight to the situation of the LGBTQI community in Israel in comparison to the situation in Germany and discuss the history and developments in the specific national context. With regard to the situation in Israel, the workshop will discuss the difficulties of negotiating the factual freedom to sexual self-determination and expression with strong conservative (religious) groups. The workshop seeks to facilitate a discussion between the German and Israeli participants to learn from each other when it comes to concrete action and trying to improve the situation of the LGBTQI community in both Israel & Germany.

Workshop 2: Religious minorities in German & Israeli universities - Shila Erlbaum

While Israel is relatively advanced when it comes to the treatment of a diverse student population, in Germany, students who belong to religious minorities (like Jews or Muslims) frequently encounter problems in higher education due to their religion. One such prominent example are holiday regulations for religious minorities in universities. In this panel, speakers are invited to give a brief input on the topic from their perspective. Participants are invited to ask questions and afterwards discuss how experiences of both countries with the topic of holiday regulations could be made use of/implemented.

Workshop 3: TikTok and antisemitism in social Media - Jonathan Guggenberger

In the workshop we will look at the basic elements of anti-Semitic representations in the field of social media. For this purpose we will first give a short input that builds on the content of the previous introductory workshops. Afterwards, we will describe social media posts, primarily TikTok videos, and examine their anti-Semitic content with the help of the previously acquired tools and information.
